

## **“Things We Should Confess”**

### **Confession List taken from “Feeding Your Faith”**

---

#### **- (1) What God in Christ has worked for us in His plan of redemption...**

- **Galatians 3:13-14 (KJV)** Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree: 14 That the blessing of Abraham might come on the Gentiles through Jesus Christ; that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.
  - **Confession:** *I am redeemed from the curse of the law because Jesus was made a curse for me. The blessing of Abraham is on me, I have received the promise of the Spirit through my faith in Jesus.*
- **Colossians 1:12-14 (KJV)** Giving thanks unto the Father, which hath made us meet to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in light: 13 Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into the kingdom of his dear Son: 14 In whom we have redemption through his blood, even the forgiveness of sins:
  - **Confession:** *God has qualified me to experience the inheritance of the saints. I am delivered from the power of darkness. I am translated into the kingdom of God. Through my faith in the blood of Jesus, I am redeemed and I am forgiven of all sin.*

#### **- (2) What God through the Holy Spirit has worked “in us” through the new birth and the infilling of the Holy Spirit...**

- **2 Corinthians 5:17-19 (KJV)** Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new. 18 And all things are of God, who hath reconciled us to himself by Jesus Christ, and hath given to us the ministry of reconciliation; 19 To wit, that God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto himself, not imputing their trespasses unto them; and hath committed unto us the word of reconciliation...21 For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him.

## “Things We Should Confess”

### Confession List taken from “Feeding Your Faith”

- **Confession**: *I am in Christ, therefore I am a new creature. The old things, my old sin nature has passed away, and all things are new. God was in Christ reconciling me to himself, restoring me to divine favor and blessing. In Christ, God does not impute my trespasses to me. God made Jesus to be sin for me, therefore, I am the righteousness of God in Christ Jesus.*
- **1 Corinthians 1:4-8 (KJV)** I thank my God always on your behalf, for the grace of God which is given you by Jesus Christ; 5 That in every thing ye are enriched by him, in all utterance, and in all knowledge; 6 Even as the testimony of Christ was confirmed in you: 7 So that ye come behind in no gift; waiting for the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ: 8 Who shall also confirm you unto the end, that ye may be blameless in the day of our Lord Jesus Christ.
- **Confession**: *I have received the grace of God, it was given to me by Jesus. I am enriched in everything. I am enriched in all utterance, and in all knowledge. The testimony of Christ was confirmed in me, and I come behind in no gift. Jesus confirms me until the end, that in the day of the Lord Jesus Christ, I am blameless.*
- **John 16:13-16 (KJV)** Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak: and he will shew you things to come. 14 He shall glorify me: for he shall receive of mine, and shall shew it unto you. 15 All things that the Father hath are mine: therefore said I, that he shall take of mine, and shall shew it unto you.
- **Confession**: *The Holy Spirit guides me into all truth. He speaks to me what he hears from the Father. He tells me about my future. He glorifies Jesus in my life. He takes all the things of God and shows them to me.*
- **(3) What we are to God the Father “In Christ”...**
- **Galatians 3:26-29 (KJV)** For ye are all the children of God by faith in Christ Jesus. 27 For as many of you as have been baptized into Christ have put on Christ. 28 There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither bond nor free, there is neither male nor female: for ye are all one in Christ Jesus. 29 And if ye be Christ's, then are ye Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise.

## “Things We Should Confess”

### Confession List taken from “Feeding Your Faith”

- **Confession**: *I am a child of God through my faith in Jesus. I am Abraham’s seed and an heir according to the promise.*
- **Romans 8:14-17 (KJV)** For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God. 15 For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father. 16 The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God: 17 And if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ; if so be that we suffer with him, that we may be also glorified together.
  - **Confession**: *I am a child of God, therefore I am led by the Spirit of God. The Holy Spirit bears witness with my spirit that I am a child of God, I am an heir of God, a joint heir with Christ.*
- **Colossians 1:21-23 (KJV)** And you, that were sometime alienated and enemies in your mind by wicked works, yet now hath he reconciled 22 In the body of his flesh through death, to present you holy and unblameable and unproveable in his sight: 23 If ye continue in the faith grounded and settled, and be not moved away from the hope of the gospel, which ye have heard, and which was preached to every creature which is under heaven; whereof I Paul am made a minister;
  - **Confession**: *I am restored to God’s divine favor and blessing through the death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus. I am holy, unblameable, and unprovable in the sight of God. I continue in the faith grounded, and settled. I will not move away from the hope of the gospel which I have heard.*
- **Colossians 2:9-10 (KJV)** For in him dwelleth all the fulness of the Godhead bodily. 10 And ye are complete in him, which is the head of all principality and power:
  - **Confession**: *In Jesus dwells all the fullness of the Godhead, and I am complete in Him.*
- **Ephesians 2:10 (AMP)** For we are God’s [own] handiwork (His workmanship), recreated in Christ Jesus, [born anew] that we may do those good works which God predestined (planned beforehand) for us [taking paths which He prepared ahead of time], that we should walk in them [living the good life which He prearranged and made ready for us to live].

### Confession List taken from “Feeding Your Faith”

- **Confession:** *I am God’s workmanship recreated in Christ Jesus. I am born anew. I do the good works God created me to do. I take the paths God prepared for me. I walk the paths God prepared for me, and I live the good life which He prearranged and made read for me to live.*
  
- **(4) What Jesus is doing for us “now” at the right hand of the Father making intercession for us...**
  - **Romans 8:32-34 (KJV)** He that spared not his own Son, but delivered him up for us all, how shall he not with him also freely give us all things? 33 Who shall lay any thing to the charge of God's elect? It is God that justifieth. 34 Who is he that condemneth? It is Christ that died, yea rather, that is risen again, who is even at the right hand of God, who also maketh intercession for us.
    - **Confession:** *God did not spare Jesus, but delivered him up for me, and with Jesus God freely gives me all things. Jesus is risen from the dead, He is at the right hand of the Father, making intercession for me.*
  - **Hebrews 7:24-25 (KJV)** But this man, because he continueth ever, hath an unchangeable priesthood. 25 Wherefore he is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by him, seeing he ever liveth to make intercession for them.
    - **Confession:** *Jesus is my high priest forever. Jesus keeps me safe and sound to the uttermost. Jesus heals me to the uttermost. Jesus ever lives to make intercession for me.*
  - **Hebrews 9:12-14 (KJV)** Neither by the blood of goats and calves, but by his own blood he entered in once into the holy place, having obtained eternal redemption for us. 13 For if the blood of bulls and of goats, and the ashes of an heifer sprinkling the unclean, sanctifieth to the purifying of the flesh: 14 How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without spot to God, purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?
    - **Confession:** *Jesus entered in holy of holies through his blood, and obtained eternal redemption for me. Therefore I am redeemed. The blood of Jesus*

*purges my conscience from the dead works of the past. The blood of Jesus purges the replays of my mind.*

- **Hebrews 13:20-21 (AMP)** Now may the God of peace [Who is the Author and the Giver of peace], Who brought again from among the dead our Lord Jesus, that great Shepherd of the sheep, by the blood [that sealed, ratified] the everlasting agreement (covenant, testament), 21 Strengthen (complete, perfect) and make you what you ought to be and equip you with everything good that you may carry out His will; [while He Himself] works in you and accomplishes that which is pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ (the Messiah); to Whom be the glory forever and ever (to the ages of the ages). Amen (so be it).
  - **Confession:** *Because of the blood of Jesus I am strong. Because of the blood of Jesus I am complete. Because of the blood of Jesus I am perfect in Him. Because of the blood of Jesus, I am equipped with everything good to carry out the will of God for my life. Because of the blood of Jesus, God himself is working in me and accomplishing what is pleasing in His sight.*
- **Hebrews 4:14-16 (KJV)** Seeing then that we have a great high priest, that is passed into the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our profession. 15 For we have not an high priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin. 16 Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need.
  - **Confession:** *Jesus is my high priest, therefore I hold fast to my confession of faith. I come boldly to the throne of grace to obtain mercy and grace to help me in my time of need.*

#### - (5) What God can do through us... What His word can do through our lips...

- **John 14:12-14 (KJV)** Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these

shall he do; because I go unto my Father. 13 And whatsoever ye shall ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. 14 If ye shall ask any thing in my name, I will do it.

- **Confession**: *I believe in Jesus, the works He did, I do also. Whatever I command in the name of Jesus, Jesus does. I command people to be healed in the name of Jesus, and Jesus heals. I command demons to leave people in the name of Jesus, and Jesus delivers.*
- **Matthew 17:20 (KJV)** And Jesus said unto them, Because of your unbelief: for verily I say unto you, If ye have faith as a grain of mustard seed, ye shall say unto this mountain, Remove hence to yonder place; and it shall remove; and nothing shall be impossible unto you.
  - **Confession**: *I have faith and it is living like a grain of mustard seed. Therefore, I speak to things and they obey, and nothing is impossible to me.*
- **Philippians 2:13-14 (AMP)** [Not in your own strength] for it is God Who is all the while effectually at work in you [energizing and creating in you the power and desire], both to will and to work for His good pleasure and satisfaction and delight. 14 Do all things without grumbling and faultfinding and complaining [against God] and questioning and doubting [among yourselves],
  - **Confession**: *God is effectually at work in me. God energizes me with His strength. He is creating in me the power and desire to do His will. Therefore, I do all things without grumbling, faultfinding, and complaining against God. I do all things without questioning and doubting.*
- **Ephesians 3:20 (AMP)** Now to Him Who, by (in consequence of) the [action of His] power that is at work within us, is able to [carry out His purpose and] do superabundantly, far over and above all that we [dare] ask or think [infinitely beyond our highest prayers, desires, thoughts, hopes, or dreams]—
  - **Confession**: *The power of God is working in me. Therefore, God is carrying out His purpose in my life. God is doing superabundantly, far over and above all I dare ask or think. God is doing infinitely beyond my highest prayers, desires, thoughts, hopes or dreams.*
- **Ephesians 3:20 (TPT)** Never doubt God’s mighty power to work in you and accomplish all this. He will achieve infinitely more than your greatest request, your most unbelievable dream, and exceed your

wildest imagination! He will outdo them all, for his miraculous power constantly energizes you.

- **Confession:** *God's mighty power is working in me to accomplish His will. God's miraculous power constantly energizes me. Therefore, He is achieving infinitely more than my greatest request, my most unbelievable dream. God is exceeding my wildest imagination. He is outdoing them all.*
- **Luke 10:17-19 (KJV)** And the seventy returned again with joy, saying, Lord, even the devils are subject unto us through thy name. 18 And he said unto them, I beheld Satan as lightning fall from heaven. 19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.
  - **Confession:** *Jesus has given me power to trample on the devil and demons. Jesus has given me authority over all the power of the enemy, therefore nothing shall by any means hurt me.*
- **Mark 16:15-18, 20 (KJV)** And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. 16 He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned. 17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; 18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.... 20 And they went forth, and preached every where, the Lord working with them, and confirming the word with signs following. Amen.
  - **Confession:** *I am a believer, and these signs follow me because I believe. In the name of Jesus I cast out demons, and I speak in tongues. In the name of Jesus, no danger known or unknown hurts me. In the name of Jesus, I lay hands on the sick and they recover. I preach the gospel wherever I go, and the Lord works with me confirming His word with signs following.*
